ELIGIBILITY

The Phoenixville area is known for its tradition of volunteerism, neighborly outlook, and commitment to community. Many people right in the heart of our community continue this tradition today. SELECTION

A Community Advisory Committee will review individual nominations for this award and select the awardees. Award winners will be notified and a recognition luncheon will be held to honor them. All nominees will be acknowledged and honored.

Additionally, each winner will be invited to direct a grant of \$2,000, in their name, to a Phoenixville area qualified charitable organization of their choice.

Up to four (4) people will be given “Champions of the Community” awards.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

Here are some criteria to consider as you prepare your written nomination. Nominees will be evaluated and selected by the Community Advisory Committee based on their achievement in **at least two** of the following categories:

1. Made a personal sacrifice to improve the lives of their neighbors.
2. Overcame a social, financial or physical setback to improve their lives.
3. Served as a mentor for youth or role model for others to follow who may be trying to overcome extenuating circumstances.
4. Provided spiritual and moral leadership in the community.
5. Utilized an innovative approach to solve a community problem.
6. Excelled academically and in extra-curricular activities at a time when odds were against them.
7. Solved a problem that preserved a healthy family environment for their immediate or extended family.
8. Made a positive change by taking control of their lives (i.e., a youth overcoming drug addiction or leaving a life of crime)
9. Length of community service.

REMEMBER: It is best to assume the Committee does not know your nominee – please help us to understand the impact of the person’s work.

Nominees must demonstrate good character and healthy life choices at the time of their nomination.

- ATTACH A HANDWRITTEN/TYPED NOMINATION NARRATIVE OF NO MORE THAN TWO PAGES
- SIGN YOUR NOMINATION NARRATIVE
