GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

LEVEL ONE: *Creating avenues for, or improving access to, direct health care services*

- **Daemion Counseling Services:** \$4,000 for mental health counseling for Phoenixville area residents
- **Transportation Management Association of Chester County:** \$15,000 for the Ride for Health Initiative

LEVEL TWO: *Services addressing health, human service & quality of life issues for the fragile, disabled and those at risk of falling further behind socially & economically*

- **Chester County OIC:** \$10,000 for the Phoenixville Youth Initiative
- **Domestic Violence Center of Chester County:** \$10,000 for the Phoenixville area counselor/advocate
- **Friends Association for the Care & Protection of Children:** \$3,000 for outreach case management for homeless families within the greater Phoenixville region
- **Meals on Wheels:** \$5,000 for services to homebound Phoenixville residents
- **Mom's House:** \$5,000 for general operating support
- **Open Hearth Inc.:** \$10,000 for general operating support
- **Phoenixville Area Positive Alternatives:** \$15,000: \$10,000 for general operating support; \$5,000 for the Communities That Care Community Mobilizer
- **St. Peter's Episcopal Church:** \$1,500 for the hot lunch program
- **Stepping Stone Education Center of Phoenixville:** \$6,000 for scholarship support
- **Variety-A Children's Charity:** \$5,000 for camp scholarship for children with disabilities within the greater Phoenixville region

LEVEL THREE: *Social/Civic/Economic Health Related Services and Capacity Building Services for Local Non-Profit Groups*

- **Phoenixville Public Library:** \$9,000 for general operating support
- **The Daniel Foundation:** \$1,500 as a matching grant in support of the Phoenixville Center for Non-Profit Excellence.
